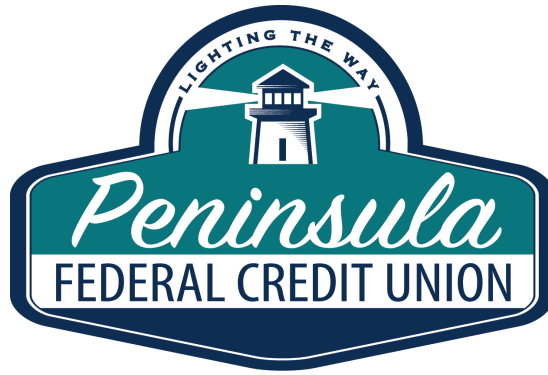

Essays should be no more than 400 words in length and be double spaced.
