### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant **must be a member in good standing** with Peninsula Federal Credit Union for a minimum of two years.
2. Peninsula Federal Credit Union's Scholarships are available for High School Seniors planning to attend college.
3. Applicants cannot be receiving 100% of tuition in the form of other scholarships
4. Board of Directors, Management, Staff of Peninsula Federal Credit Union, their immediate family members, are not eligible.
5. Completed application, essay, and transcript **must be postmarked, or received, no later than May 31, 2018**
6. Money will be awarded to the chosen applicants once their official colligate enrollment is presented to the credit union.

### ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Must include a title page containing the following information  
- Essay Title, Student's Name, Student's Address and Phone Number
- B. Your essay must be typed in 12-point size type and double spaced on 8-1/2" x 11" white paper with one-inch margins on all sides. The text of your essay should be no more than three pages excluding title page.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will base the selection of the scholarship recipients on the following:

#### 1. Application: (35 points)

- \* Community service, volunteer work, and/or extracurricular activities. (1-10 points)
- \* Honors, awards, recognitions and/or leadership achievements (1-10 points)
- \* Education/career goals and how scholarship will help you in obtaining these goals (1-10 points)
- \* Compliance with required format (1-5 points)

#### 2. Essay: (65 Points)

- \* Quality of essay (1-50 points)
- \* Grammar, punctuation, spelling, and neatness (1-10 points)
- \* Compliance with required format (1-5 points)
