- ⇒ EMV (Europay, MasterCard, Visa) is a micro-chip technology that provides increased security capabilities. This is sometimes referred to as a Smart Card or Chip Card.
- ⇒ EMV cards are equipped with a small metallic square (chip) on the front of the card that stores information.
- ⇒ Originating in Europe, EMV technology has been instrumental in preventing the spread of debit card fraud, and will be the chosen method of payment in the United States within the next few years.
