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#### **Eligibility**

Applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria to be eligible:

- 1. Student *must* be a member in good standing at Peninsula Federal Credit Union.
- 2. Student *must* be enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school during the year listed on the scholarship application.
- 3. Student must maintain a GPA of 2.50 or higher.
- 4. Student *must* attend the college, university, or trade school during the year listed on the scholarship application.
- 5. Student *must not* be an immediate family member of a Peninsula Federal Credit Union employee or volunteer.
- 6. Essay: Double spaced and no more than 400 words in length.

Topic: "Describe a time when you used your leadership skills to make a positive impact in your community/school/organization and explain how these experiences have shaped your plans to give back to your community in the future."

#### **Application Requirements**

- 1. Applications must be received by April 11, 2025.
- 2. Applications must be filled out completely and be either typed or written in black ink.
- 3 Applications must be submitted one of the following ways:

#### **Selection Process**

All applications will be reviewed by the Peninsula Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee. This committee is made up of the Peninsula Federal Credit Union Board of Directors and/or employees of the credit union.

### **Payment Process**

The scholarship will be awarded after June 6, 2025. Monies will be paid directly to the accredited college, university, or trade school. Students must provide Peninsula FCU with their student ID number or school account number for monies to be paid to the school of their choice.
