

Eligibility

Applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria to be eligible:

- 1. Student *must* be a member in good standing of Peninsula Federal Credit Union.
- 2. Student *must* be enrolled in an accredited College, University, or trade school during the school year listed on the scholarship application.
- 3. Student *must* maintain a GPA of 2.50.
- 4. Student *must* attend the college, university, or trade school during the school year listed on the scholarship application.
- 5. An essay on the topic of "What does it mean to be a good student on the field, in the classroom, and in the community?" must be submitted by the applicant. Essays should be no more than 400 words in length and be double spaced.

Application Requirements

- 1. All applications must be received by April 10, 2023.
- 2. Application must be filled out completely and be either typed or written in black ink.

Selection Process

All applications will be reviewed by the Peninsula Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee. This committee is made up of members of the Peninsula Federal Credit Union Board of Directors and employees of the Credit Union.

Payment Process

The scholarship will be awarded after May 25, 2023, monies will be sent directly to the college, university, or trade school of choice and credited in the winner's name.
